### 8 List of Students (avatar and name)

Will list all log-in students with the student's avatars and names. When mouse-over on a student, the student will be highlighted. Users can either click and hold the mouse to drag the student (to the whiteboard) or click on the message icon to send the student a message.

### 9 Pod View icon

Click on the icon to enter the pod's view mode.

### 1 The master Session header bar

By default, will display the Master session's name and the total number of the student in the session. Double-click on the Master Session text and input/edit the session's name.

### 2 Mute all and Camera-off all toggles

Click on the toggle to turn on/off all students' microphones or cameras. By default, it will be off. To clarify, the "Off" means not mute.

### 3 Drawer open/close icon

Click on the icon to open/close the side drawer panel.

### 4 Session modes switcher

Click on the icon to change the session's modes from Whiteboard, Dual mode, and Gallery mode.

### 5 Teacher's camera view

Will display the teacher's camera and the teacher's name will be displayed underneath.

### 6 Side arrow for browsing more

When there are more students than the bar can display, on the right side, an arrow icon will be displayed when mouse-over the area. Click on the arrow to the right to browse more students. When it slides to the right side, the left side arrow icons will appear, so users can click on it to slide the row to the left. When rolling out, the arrow icons will disappear after a few seconds.

### 7 Side-drawer navigation bar

The icons will have an on/off status to display the selected one. Click an icon to change the drawer content from Students, Chat, Questions, Library, Quiz, and Emoji. Under the Navi items, a row with text will display the currently displayed content. By default, the "Students" will be pre-selected.

### 1 Pods view header bar

When switching to pod view mode, the header bar will show the # of learning pods and the # of total students.

### 2 Master Session container

As a default, the master session container will be pre-selected. The header bar will show the Master session and the # of current students in the session. The message and question indicators will show up when there are new messages and questions.

### 3 Student List

Will list out the students with student's avatars, names, and status icons for the microphone and camera. Users can click and hold on a student to start dragging it.

### 4 New learning pod slots

By default, when the first time switched to learning pods view mode, no pod was created. Users can either click on an empty slot or drag a student to a slot to create a new pod.

### 5 Home icon

Click on the icon, leave the pods view mode, and return to the master session.
