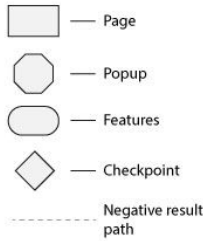
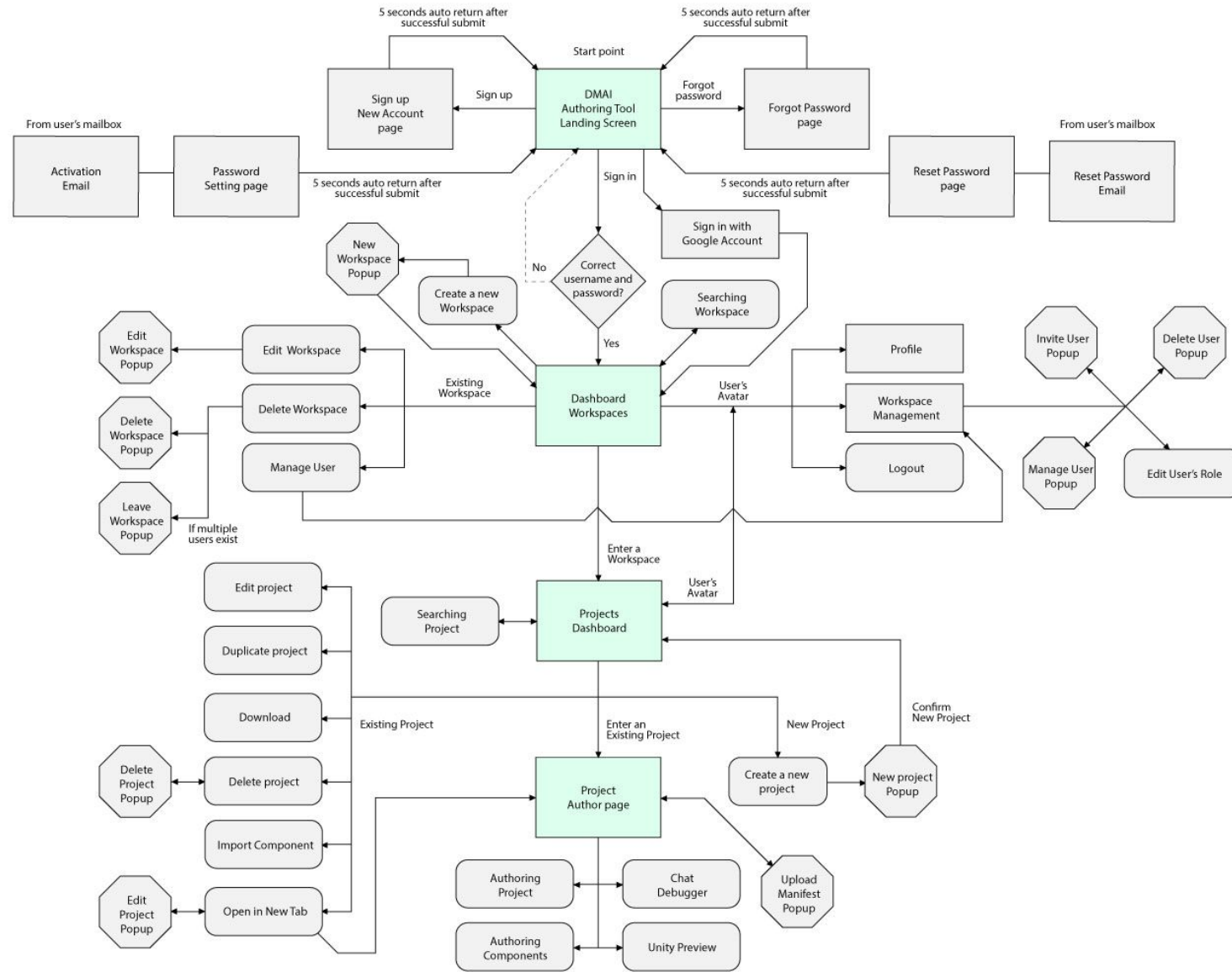


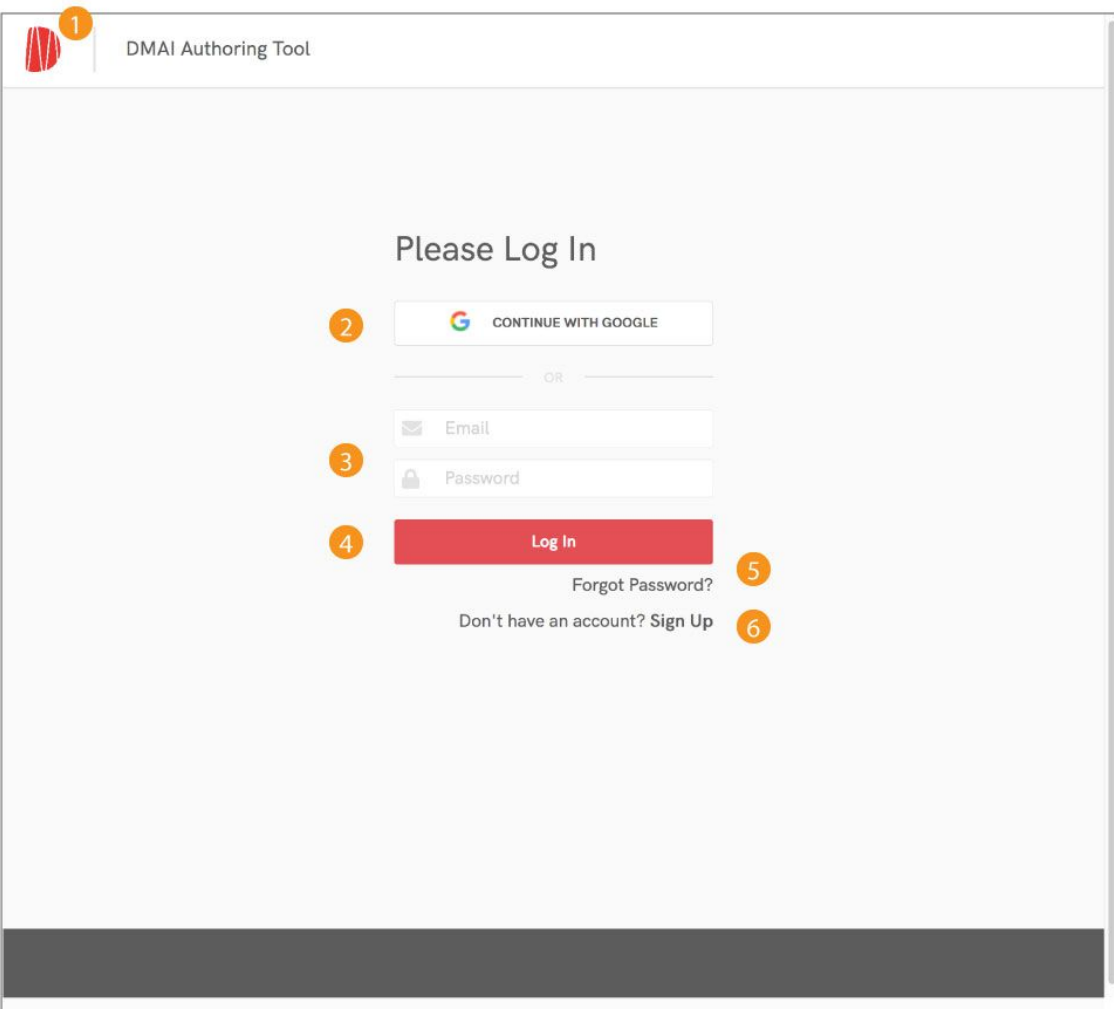

### 1 Product logo and Website header

### 2 Sign in with Google Account

Users can click on the button to sign in with their Google account. Click on the button to launch the Google confirmation popup.

### 3 User email and password input fields

Click on the field to input the email and password. By default (without any input or before typing anything), the text "Email" and "Password" will be displayed in the fields.

### 4 Log in Button

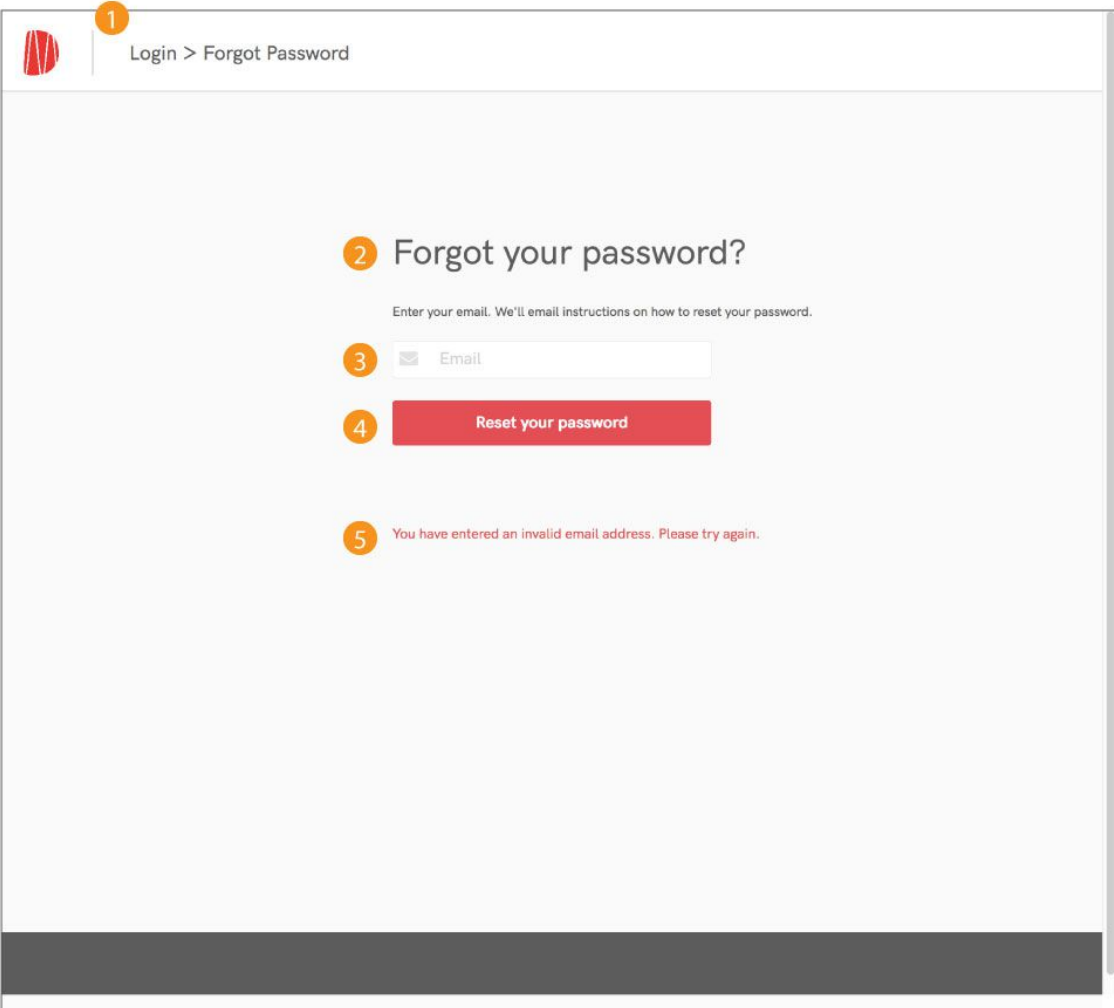
Click on the button will submit the username and password to the server.

### 5 Forgot Password text link

Click on the text will bring users to the Forgot Password page.

### 6 Sign Up text link

Click on the link will bring users to the Sign-up page.



1 **Web page breadcrumbs**

2 **Web page header and short instruction**

3 **Email address input field**

Click on the field to input. By default (without any input or before typing anything), the text "Email" will be displayed in the field.

4 **Reset password Button**

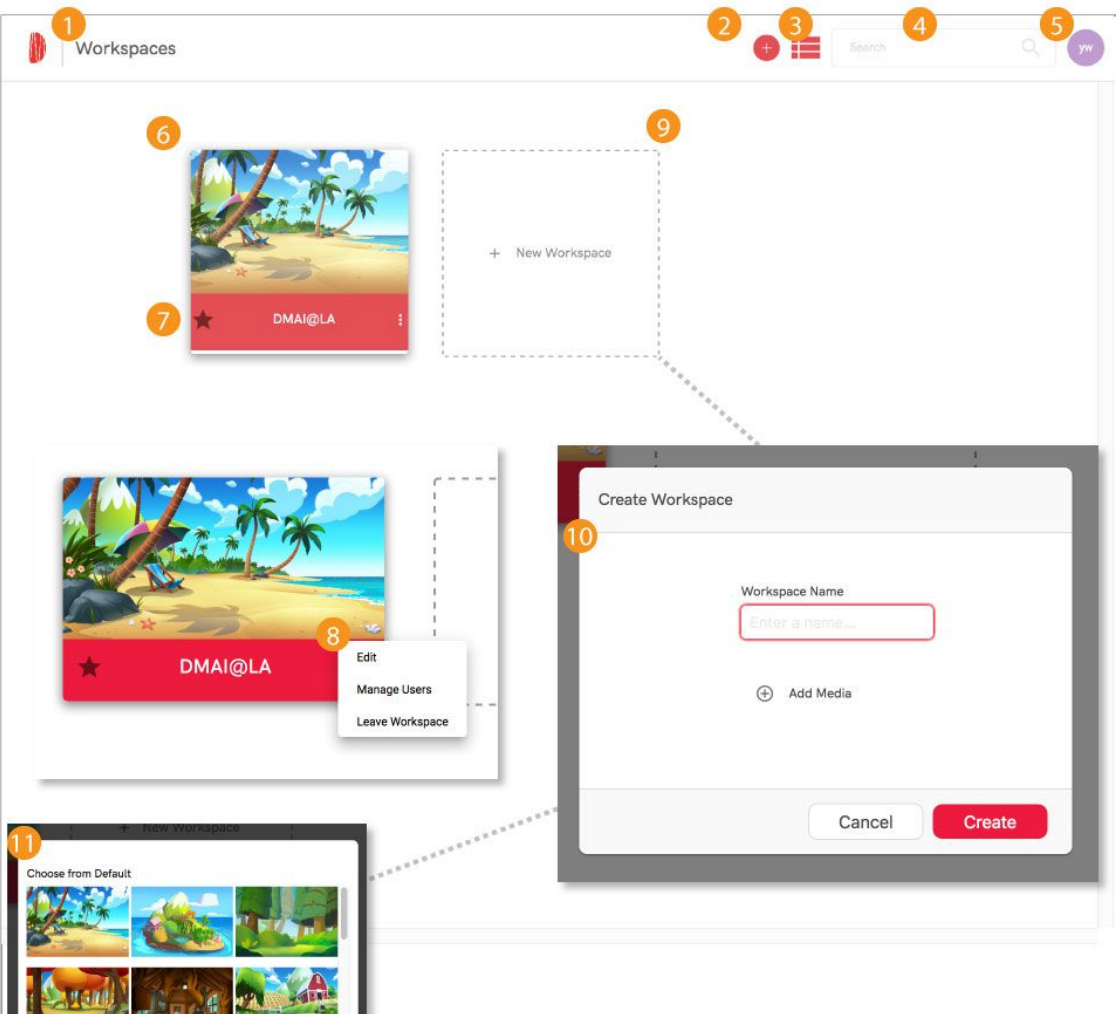
Click on the button to submit the email.

9 **Error message**

If users input an invalid email address and hit the reset button, the error message shows up here.

**Note:**

Once users submit their email, the confirmation message will appear underneath and automatically bring them back to the login page after 5 seconds.



**10 Add workspace media (cover image) popup**

The popup will have 6 pre-selected images that users can click on or they can click on the "Choose File" button to upload an image from their devices. Click on the "OK" button to submit. Default workspace cover image will be applied if users didn't choose/upload an image.

**1 Website logo and page breadcrumbs**

**2 Create a new workspace icon**

Click on the icon to launch the create new workspace popup.

**3 List view mode icon**

Click on the icon to switch to workspace list view mode.

**4 Searching field**

Users can input key-words to narrow down the displayed workspaces. Searching based on the real-time rules which mean the search result will be displayed immediately on the page without clicking on the magnifier icon.

**5 User profile icon**

By default, will display the users' initial (first and last name). Click on the icon will open the drop-down menu with the following options, user's email, Profile, Workspace management, and Log out.

**6 Existing workspace brick**

A workspace brick will include, workspace cover image, preferred star icon, name, and the hamburger icon. Click on a workspace cover image will go to that workspace page. Double click on the project's name can start editing the workspace's name.

**7 Workspace preferred star**

Click on the star icon will set the workspace as preferred. The icon will have on/off status.

**8 Workspace hamburger menu**

By clicking on the hamburger icon, the menu will show up with the following options, Edit workspace (with edit popup), Manage users (go to workspace management page), and leave/delete workspace (popup).

**9 Create new workspace brick**

Click on the brick to launch the create new workspace popup.

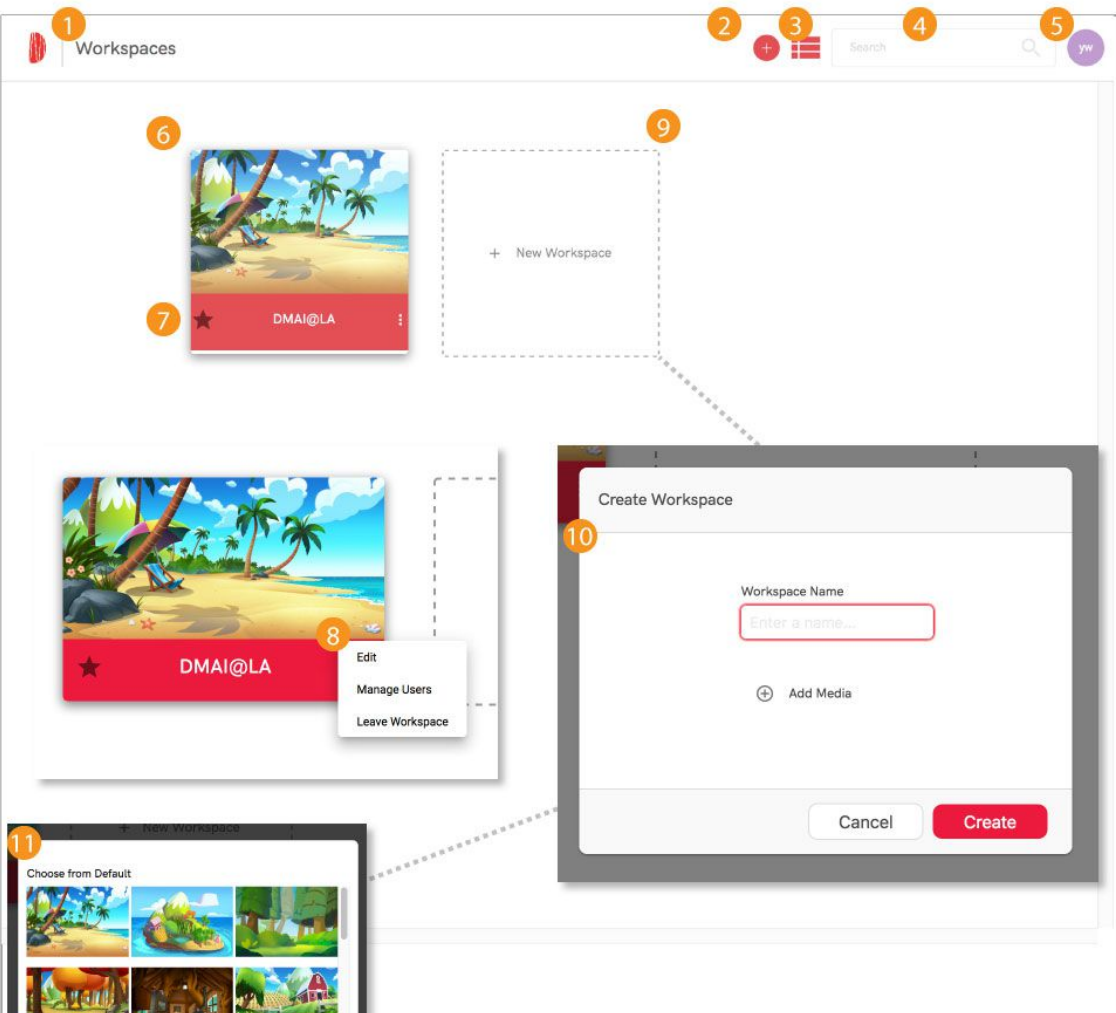
**10 Create new workspace popup**

The popup will include the header text, workspace name input field, add workspace media (cover image) button, cancel button and create button. Click on the Add Media link will load the image selection popup.

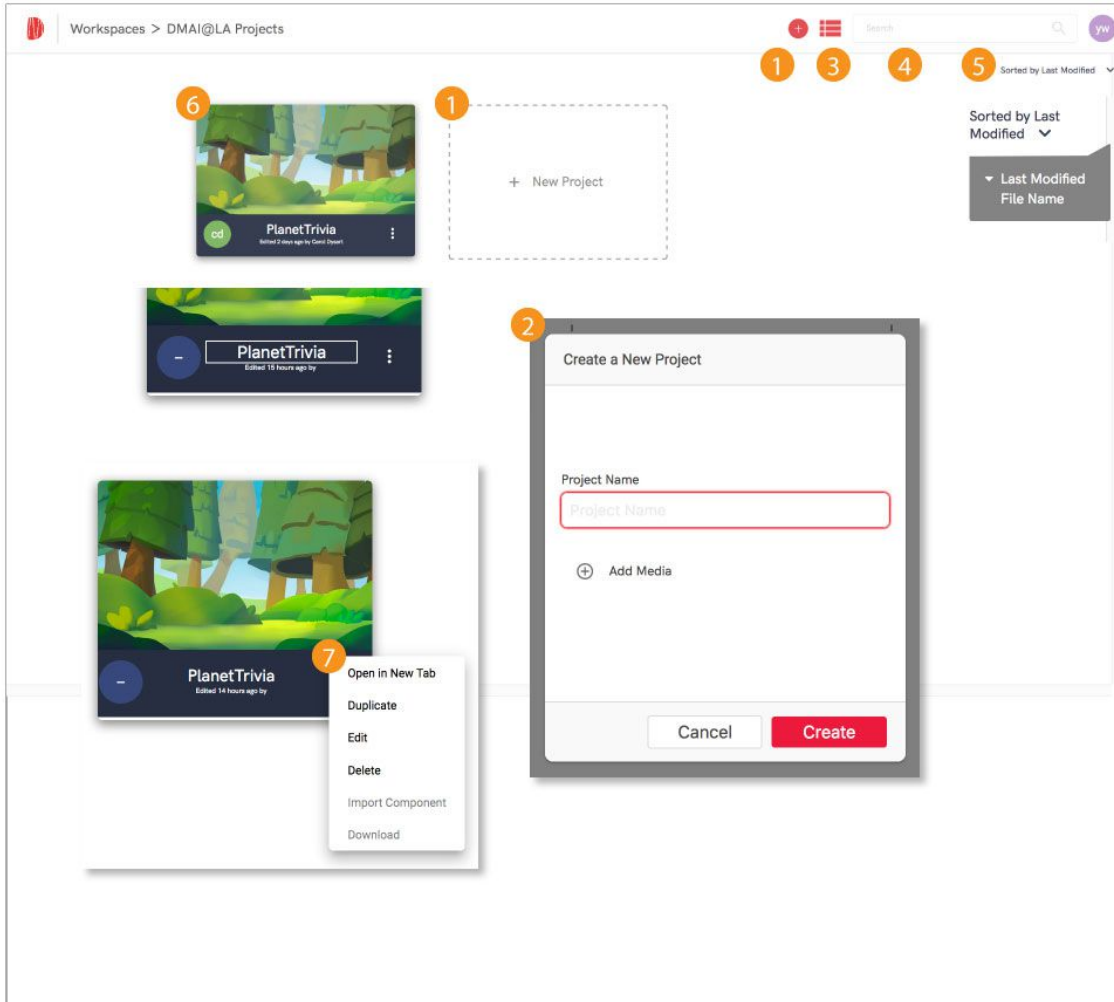

**1 Create new project icon & brick**

Click on the icon or the new project brick to open the Create new project popup.

**2 Create new project popup**

Similar to the Create New Workspace popup, Users will need to input the new project name and/or add the project cover image. Click on the Create button to submit the request and close the popup. Click on the Cancel button to close the popup w/o creating the new project.

**3 List view mode icon**

Click on the icon to switch to Projects list view mode.

**4 Searching field**

Users can input keywords to narrow down the displayed projects. Searching is based on real-time rules, which means the search result will be displayed immediately on the page without clicking on the magnifier icon.

**5 Sort-by switcher**

By default, the page will display projects by the order of the last modified date. Users can click on the text and change to sort by the project's name (alphabet).

**6 Existing workspace brick**

An existing project brick will include the project cover image, project name, the project owner's initial icon, and the date/time of the last edited. Click on the project cover image, and it will go to that project author page. Double-click on a project's name text will start editing the

**7 Project hamburger menu**

By clicking on the hamburger icon, the menu will show up with the following options:

- Open in a new tab - open project in a new browser tab
- Duplicate - copy/duplicate the project on the page
- Edit - open the project edit popup (change the project's name or cover image)
- Delete - Delete the project (confirmation popup)
- Import Component
- Download

### 1 Chat Debugger header

Will display the chat debugger header.

### 2 Expert mode indicator/switcher

Will show the current mode (Expert mode/Basic mode). Clicking on the text will switch the debugger between the Expert mode and Basic mode.

### 3 Chat debugger display body

When running debugger, the chat content will be displayed here.

### 4 Intents input field

Click on the field to start typing for the intents.

### 5 Utterances input field

Click on the field to start typing for the utterances.

### 6 Debugger play icon

Click on the icon to start playing Debugger.

### 7 Debugger replay icon

Click on the icon to restart playing Debugger from the beginning.

### 8 Expert mode/Basic mode switcher icon

Clicking on the icon will switch debugger between the Expert mode and Basic mode.

### 9 Preview close icon

Clicking on the icon to close the preview window.
