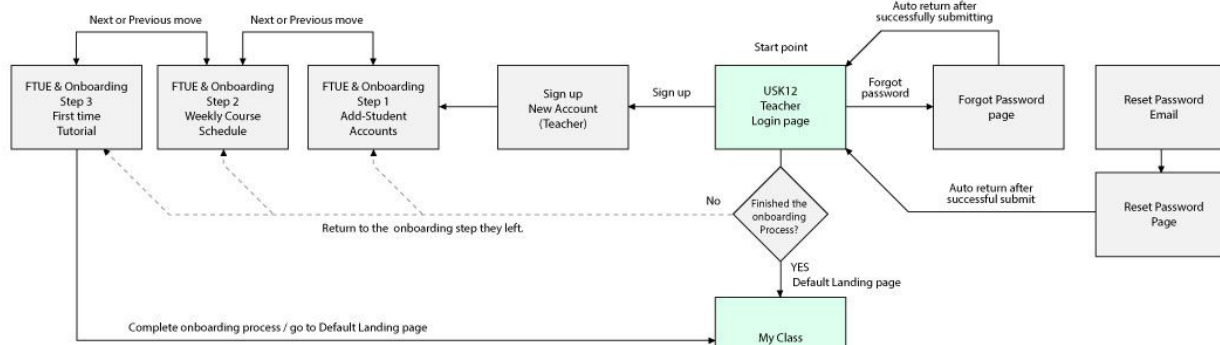

Notes (sign-in):

- Login will be separated for Teachers and students.
- Students will log in to their account with the student code generated by the teacher (students may change/edit their student code for their own protection).
- Student accounts will belong to the teacher's account.

Notes (Onboarding & first-time experience):

- First-time users will go through a few steps onboarding processes to help them get started.
- New users can add student accounts during the first-time onboarding process.
- New users can set up this weekly course schedule during the first-time onboarding process.
- New users will be offered a first-time tutorial for the main features on My Class screen.

Notes (My class):

- After login, teachers will land on the My Class page as the primary portal page.
- My Class page will include two main sections, My Students and My Lessons

Crouse Management

- Teachers will have a view of weekly lessons. Also can switch to previous or future weeks.
- Teachers can set the subjects for repeating daily lessons.
- Teachers can add/edit/ topic for the daily lesson.
- Teachers can see the daily lesson progress.
- Teachers can see the students' real-time progress.
- Teachers can manually activate/inactivate a daily lesson.

Student Management

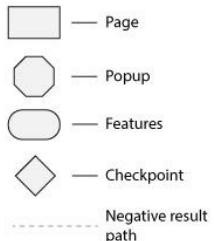
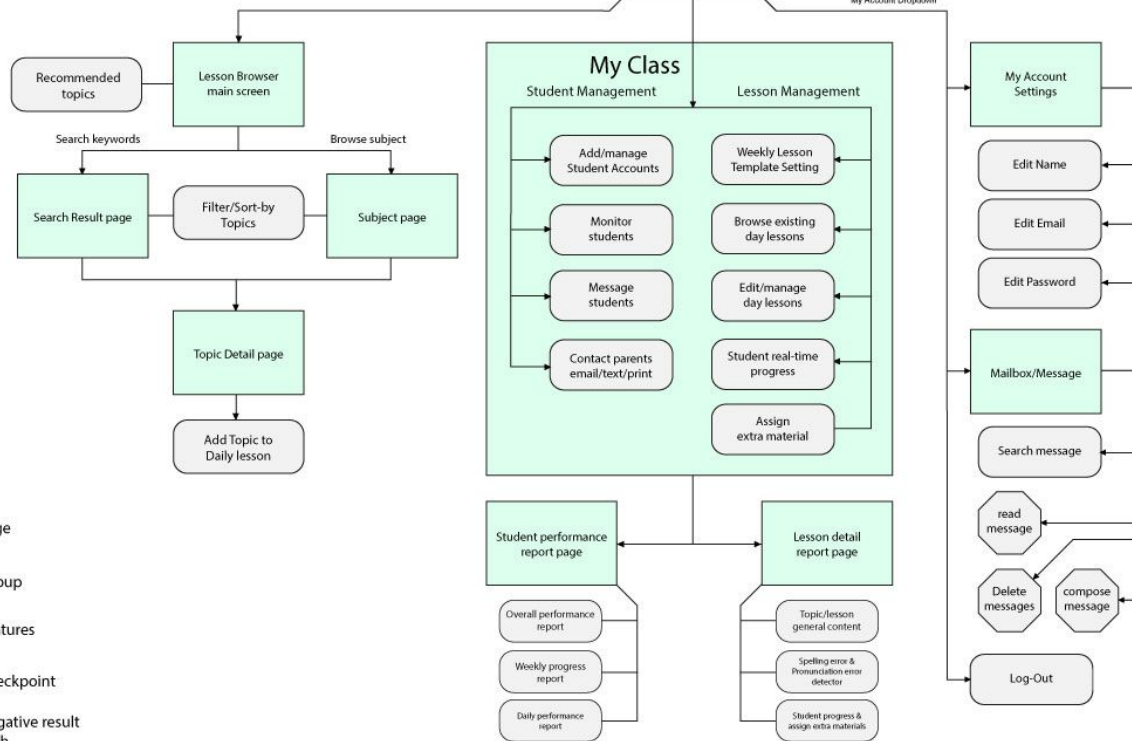
- Teachers can add/manage students' accounts.
- Teachers can monitor students' status.
- Teachers can review students' performance and assign extra material if needed.
- Teachers can communicate with the parents via email, text message.
- Teachers will be able to copy/paste student lists from their computers.

Notes (Lesson topics browser):

- Based on the class grade, the Lesson browser will show only the activities that are appropriate for the student's grade.
- Lesson activities will be grouped by subjects.
- Teachers can search lesson activities by keywords.
- Teachers can narrow down the activities by certain filter options.
- Teachers can preview a lesson activity before they decide to add it to a lesson container.
- Teachers can add single or multiple (selected) activities to a daily lesson container.

Notes (My Account):

- Teachers will be able to edit their name, email address (login username), and password.
- Teachers will be able to browse/read messages from their students and/or parents.
- Teachers will be able to send messages

1 Website header and welcome sentence

2 Email Address input field

Click on the field to input the account email account. By default (without any input or before typing anything), the text "Email Address" will be displayed in the field.

3 Password input field

Click on the field to input the Password. By default (without any input or before typing anything), the text "Password" will be displayed in the field.

4 Login error message

For the cases of either an invalid username/email address or an incorrect password, the error message will show up here and push the content underneath to the bottom.

5 Check the box for remembering login

Before clicking on the login button, users can click on this check box to select or deselect the option to remember their log in the next time when they visit the site. The checkbox, along with the text "Remember Me," will be clickable.

6 Forgot Password text link

Click on the text will bring users to the Forgot Password page.

7 Log in Button

The button will be inactivated and gray-out until users have input on both username and password fields. Click on the button will submit the username and password to the server.

8 Sign-up text link

Click on the text will link to the sign-up account page

9 Website footer for Terms of service, Privacy policy, and Help

Click on the text links will bring users to the page. Website footer text links will be displayed at the bottom of all the pages.

2 Delete student icon

Click on the icon will remove/delete the student account from the class.

3 Students list scroll-bar

Only the student list will be in the scrollable area; The scroll bar will show up when there are more students than it can display in the area (we will try to keep the Next and Previous buttons always on the screen).

4 Instruction sub-text

Will remind the teachers that they can add, edit, and manage their students on the My Class screen.

5 Previous steps / Back button

Users will be able to move forward or backward for the onboarding process without losing whatever they created and/or changed (for example, the student list here). Click on the button will bring the users back to the previous page (print user login information).

6 Next button (skip)

Click on the button will bring the users to the next step (the weekly course schedule) page. It will show the Skip button instead of the Next button until at least one student account has been created.

Design Concept

To provide teachers with a more straightforward way to manage their classes, we combine the students' page and lessons page into one My Class screen as the landing page for teachers after they log in to their accounts. In general, the carrier will be divided into two sections, one on the top for managing the daily lesson and the second section underneath for managing the students in the class.

The My Lessons plan section will allow teachers to set up their weekly schedule (what days/times for the class and what subject for each day). After teachers set up their weekly class schedule, a template of weekly lessons will then allow teachers to add lesson activities into the day lesson container. With the default weekly view, the teacher can easily and quickly manage their lesson.

The list of existing students will be displayed underneath with student information. Teachers can monitor students' status, edit/manage student's accounts, add/remove student accounts (remove student is not for Oct), and communicate with students and their parents.

My Class page will be the All-in-One dashboard for teachers to handle their classes and lessons.

1 Website logo and Teacher Dashboard header

Click on this when in any sub-page will bring users back to this dashboard screen.

2 Main navigation elements

It will have My Class, Lesson Topic Browser, and My Account as the three main navigation elements. By default, after login, users will be landing on the My Class page as the landing screen. Click on a component will bring users to the destination page. The elements will have rollover status to indicate they are clickable. On the current visiting page, the navigation element will be highlighted.

3 Current week's lesson

It will have an edit icon next to the header. Click on the edit icon to change the weekly lesson template (see the popup for details).

4 Month and years

It will show the month and year for the currently displayed week lessons. My class wireframes continue on the next page

- 1
Students performance for the course
 Similar to the student list on the My Class page, The list will provide teachers with a quick view of the student's status and performance for the course.
- 2
View student detail report icon
 Click on the icon to go to the student's detail report page.
- 3
Topic performance
 Based on the student's performance in the topic assessment activity. It will display the result here. Will Display "N/A" if the student hasn't finished the assessment activity yet.
- 4
Extra material button
 Teachers can click on the icon/button to open the extra material assignment popup. The icon/button will be inactivated and grayed out if the student still needs to finish a topic. After assigning extra material to a student, it will show the assignment status as not started yet, or completed so the teacher knows if the student has finished the assignment.
- 5
Student select/check box
 Similar to the select box on the My Class page, after at least one student is selected/checked, the action buttons will show up above the student list. Three action buttons will be available here: Mmessage students, message parents, and assign extra material.

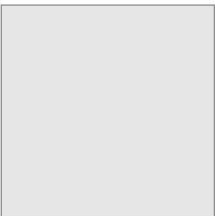

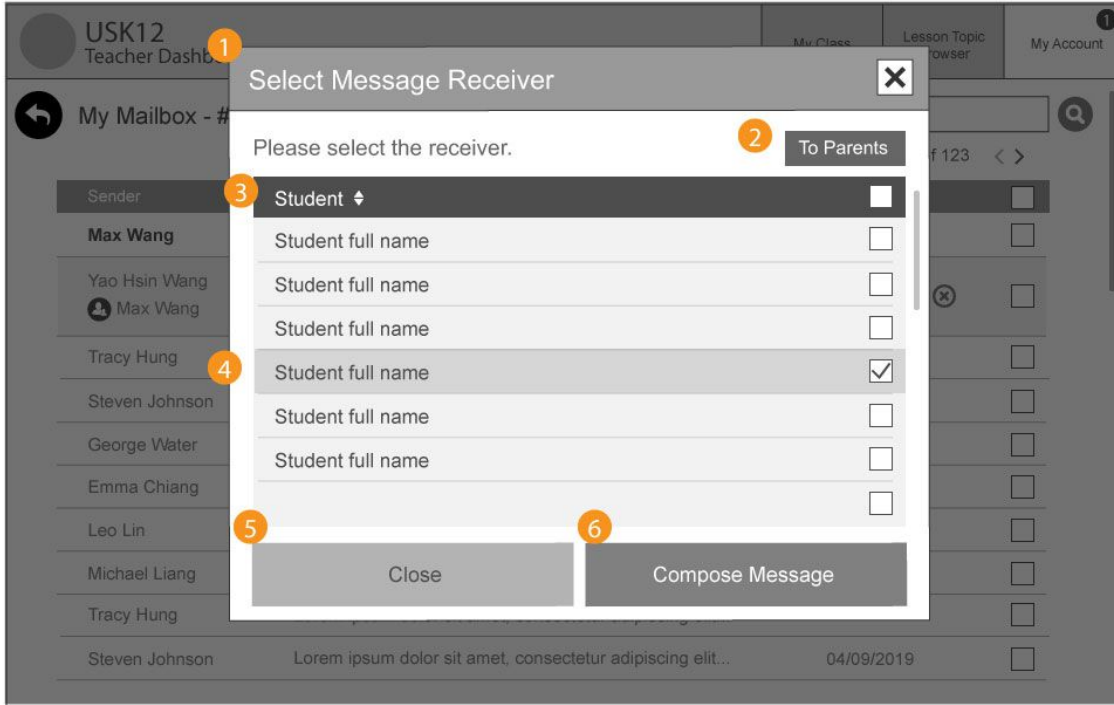

- 4 Activity type, name, and a short description**
Each activity will have the activity type, name, and short description to help teachers understand the topic content.
- 5 Extension Material**
The header of the extension material. Each topic will include one suggested extension material for students with low performance and needing more assistance/practice.
- 6 Extension Material thumbnail**
I will have the thumbnail image for the material shown here.
- 7 Extension Material name and description**
Each extension material will come with a name and a short description so teachers will know what will be assigned to the students.



1 New message receiver selection popup

The header will say "Select message receiver".

2 Students/parents group switcher

Teachers can switch between students and parents groups. Click on the button will change the receiver list table underneath. Teachers can only choose from one group at a time for a message (One message for either students or parents only). Display "To parents" button when students are listed below. One-click to change to parents list with the "To students" button displayed instead.

3 Receiver list table

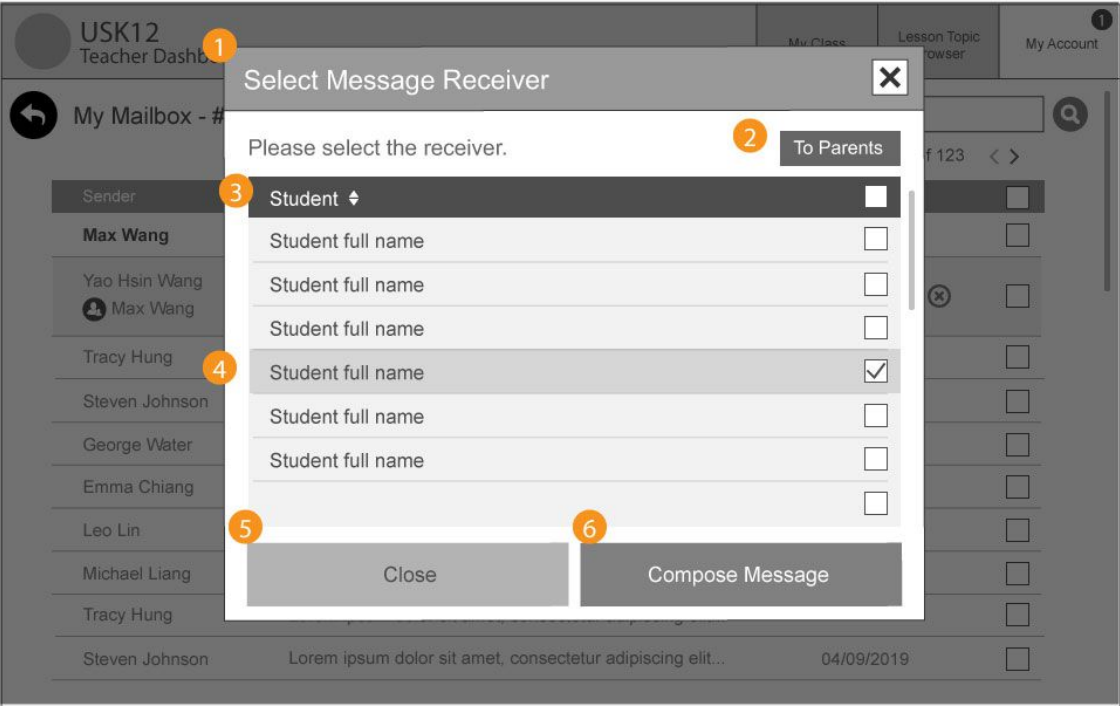
